1. Negative Coggins within 1 year required.
2. Schooling attire is allowed.
3. If you can't leave your dog at home, it MUST be on a leash at all times.
4. Reckless riding will not be tolerated, or people exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct individuals will be asked to leave the show grounds. Any refunds will be forfeited.
5. Riders showing in Leadline may show in Walk/Jog.
6. Riders showing in Walk/Jog cannot show in any Cantering classes.
7. Beginner classes in the main ring are for academy level riders.
8. Stall braids may be kept in manes & tails without penalty
9. 6 Ribbons awarded per class
10. Judge's decision is final
11. Show management has the right to Combine/Add/Cancel classes
12. Series end hi-point awards will be divided by the following age groups: 1) Under 10
2) 10 – 14 years 3) 15 – 17 years 4) 18 & Over
Riders must participate in at least 2 out of 5 shows to be eligible to win an award.
13. All Quentin Horse Shows are eligible for point accumulation with the PSHA, APHA and SVHSA. Ask for details at the show office.
